Itinerary

Day 1 Fly to Atlanta, GA. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel in Atlanta for an overnight stay.

Day 2 The day begins with an area tour of Atlanta, the New South's capital. The highlight of the day is the **Georgia Aquarium**, the nation's largest Aquarium, with fresh and salt water habitats. The aquatic life is mesmerizing and magical. We leave Atlanta and continue across Georgia to Charleston, South Carolina, where we stay for 2 nights. B, D

Day 3 After breakfast, we continue our sightseeing adventure in **Charleston** where we take a walking tour through the city's cobblestone streets. You will have a first-hand experience of Charleston life, past to present day, as you walk through the city. Charleston is the birth place of the Civil War and a vibrant city of the New South. We then take a tour of **Drayton Hall**, founded in 1738, known as the nation's earliest example of fully executed Palladian architecture and the oldest preserved plantation house in America. Next, we visit **Charleston City Market**, one of the nation's oldest public markets and the cultural heart of Charleston, where there are more than 300 entrepreneurs and vendors to experience. We will also visit **Boone Hall Plantation**, which is a "living history" and an active agricultural facility, known to be the most photographed plantation in America. It is here that you will come to know how Major John Boone made his fortune from cotton, brick making, and rice in the 1680's. B

Day 4 Today, we visit **Beaufort** and take a guided carriage ride through the historic downtown streets. See the restored historic mansions built by the wealthy families before the Civil War as they are a cultural treasure of this antebellum town. We continue on to **Savannah**, often called the "Belle of the South", and check into our hotel. We will stay 3 nights in Savannah. B, D

Day 5 Downtown **Savannah's National Landmark Historic District** is the highlight of our city tour. This tour includes a local guide who will show us around and tell us the history of this lovely city. Then we board the **Savannah Riverboat Cruise**. The cruise captain provides a narration, along the scenic Savannah River, giving us a unique perspective of this historic city. You will have free time to enjoy Savannah. Everyone will have the opportunity to explore shops, art galleries, and café's scattered throughout this walkable city. This will be the perfect time to find souvenirs. B

Day 6 Today we visit **Jekyll Island** which is our next adventure. Before World War II, famous and rich Americans came to Jekyll Island as a retreat. Some of the recognizable family names include the Rockefellers, Morgan's, Macys, Pulitzers, Goodyear's and Vanderbilt's. The state of Georgia purchased the island, which is 10 miles of Atlantic beaches, waterways, and marshes. The interior land of forests is full of pines, magnolias, and live oak trees. Wildlife of egrets, pelicans, herons and sandpipers skim the gentle surf. Then we visit the **Georgia Sea Turtle Center** where experts rescue several hundred sea turtles a year to be rehabilitated and released back to their ocean habitat. We return to Savannah to enjoy our farewell dinner. B, D

Day 7 Today we depart Savannah for the Atlanta, GA airport to board the flight home. Along the way to the Atlanta airport, we will make a stop at a quaint Georgia town. Relax and remember your experiences with the culture and history of the southern states. B

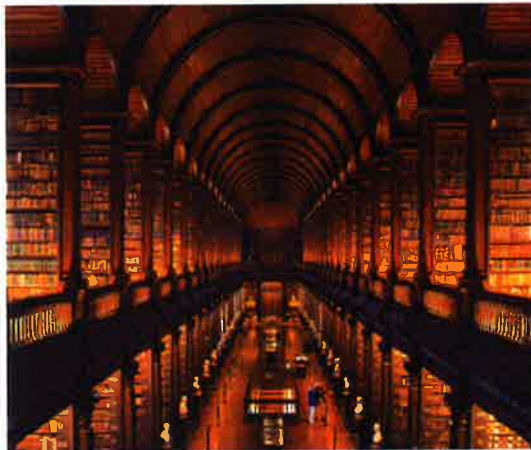

Treasures of Ireland Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight Flight to Ireland

Today board your overnight flight to experience the Treasures of Ireland.

Day 2: Arrive Dublin - Belfast Sightseeing

Arrive in Dublin and meet your **Tour Director**. Board your motorcoach and travel to Belfast, the capital of and largest city in Northern Ireland. Day 3: Giants Causeway - Titanic Belfast

Today travel to the **Giants Causeway**, often described as the Eighth Wonder of the World and declared Ireland's first World Heritage site by UNESCO in 1986. Shortly after arrival, you will see why it has become one of Ireland's top tourist attractions. Later visit **Titanic Belfast**, a museum on the site of the former Harland & Wolfe Shipyard where the Titanic was built and launched in 1912. Enjoy the evening at leisure in Belfast.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Belfast

Day 4: Belfast - Glendalough - Limerick

This morning depart Belfast and travel to **Glendalough** to see the ruins of St. Kevin's monastic site, a center of Irish Celtic Christianity. The area is also famous for its scenic vistas of the Wicklow Mountains. Continue onto **Limerick** for a two-night stay. Enjoy a **Limerick City Tour** to see the attractive St. Mary's Cathedral, King John's Castle and the Treaty Stone. Tonight is at leisure to enjoy dinner on your own.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Limerick

Day 5: Limerick - Cliffs of Moher - Galway

Today travel to the spectacular **Cliffs of Moher**. View the mighty Atlantic and the beautiful Aran Islands from atop cliffs that reach nearly 700 feet into the air. Travel through the **Burren**, an area known for limestone natural beauty. Later enjoy a **Galway City Tour** featuring St. Nicholas Cathedral & Eyre Square. Galway, "The City of Tribes" is a vibrant city with a great seafaring tradition. Tonight experience a **Medieval Banquet** featuring delicious food and traditional entertainment.

Day 6: Limerick - Adare - Killarney

This morning stop in **Adare**, renowned as Ireland's prettiest village. Next visit the **Foynes Flying Boat Museum**, housed in the original terminal building in Foynes and said to be the birthplace of "Irish" Coffee. The port of Foynes was the fulcrum point for air traffic between the U.S. and Europe in the early 1940's. Later arrive in the charming & picturesque town of **Killarney** for a two night stay. Upon arrival embark on a **Jaunting Car Ride** into the Killarney

National Park. The horse drawn Jaunting Car experience ends at the Muckross House & Garden, a 19th century Victorian mansion on the shores of Muckross Lake. Take some pictures of the house and grounds before the short motor-coach ride back to your hotel. Tonight join your fellow travelers for dinner.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight - Killarney

Day 7: Killarney - Ring of Kerry - Killarney

Today travel along one of the most gorgeous coastal routes in the world - the **Ring of Kerry**. Focus your cameras on the majestic seascapes, mountains speckled with brightly colored farm houses and winding lanes bordered with luscious vegetation. Pass through the rugged mountains and stop at **Ladies View** for wonderful vistas of the Lakes of Killarney.

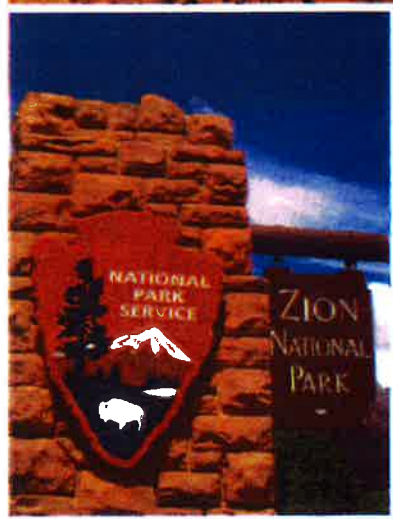
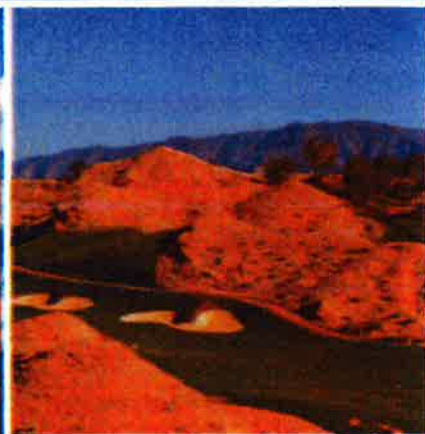

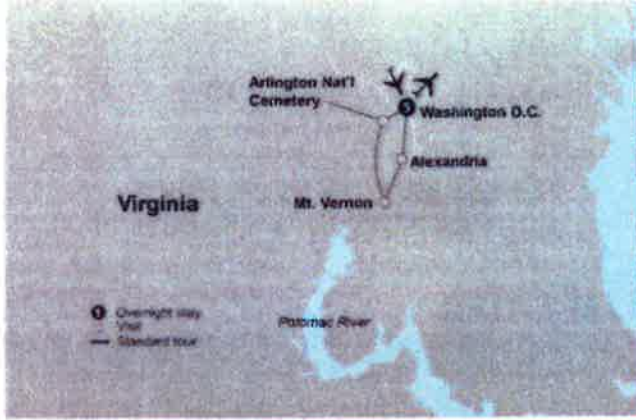

The National Cherry Blossom Festival is planned to coincide as near as possible with the blooming of the trees. "Peak Bloom Date" is defined as the day on which 70 percent of the blossoms of the Yoshino cherry trees are open. The date when the Yoshino cherry blossoms reach peak bloom varies from year-to-year, depending upon weather conditions. The mean date of blooming is April 4, but nature is not always cooperative and the National Park Service horticulturists cannot make an accurate prediction much more than 10 days prior. 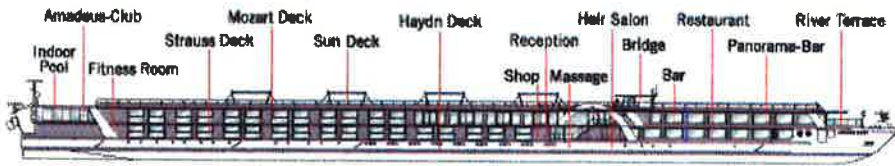

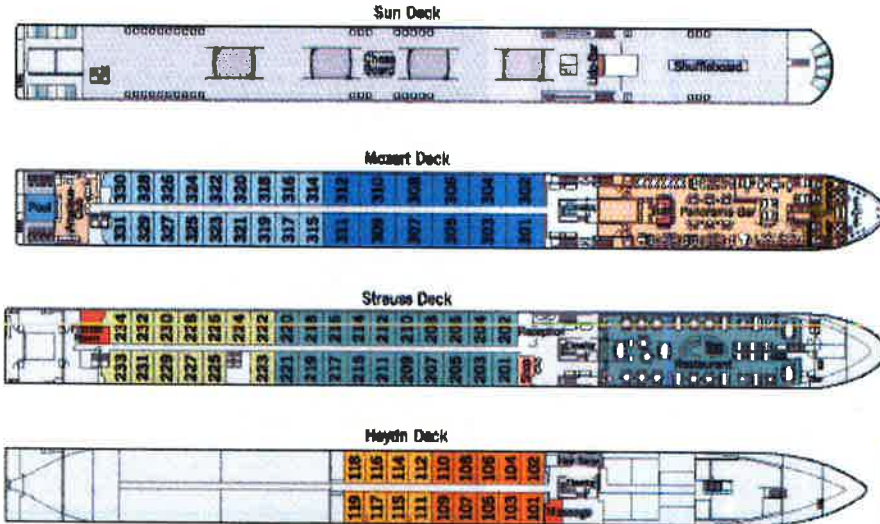
