Itinerary

Day 1: Tuesday, 2/6 - We begin the tour by flying into New Orleans; the birthplace of Jazz, where European, Caribbean, African and Hispanic cultures blend together for variety and intrigue. The food, architecture, music, and traditions are so unique and they demand to be experienced and enjoyed. Staying at the Wyndham New Orleans French Quarter (3 nights) will place you near the center of New Orleans nightlife. Enjoy a welcome dinner, where you meet your fellow travelers in one of the country's be culinary locations. (D)

Day 2: Wednesday, 2/7 - Today we take the New Orleans city tour, with a highly acclaimed local guide, who will bring life to the points of interest and reveal city secrets. The city tour will include a walking tour of the French Quarter, Bourbon Street; and your exploration will also include observing various exhibits in the National WWII Museum. The evening is yours and you'll have a chance to explore the vibrant night life of New Orleans. (B)

Moderately Active: Faster Pace, Substantial distances covered, extensive walking and stair climbing. Day 3: Thursday, 2/8 - Start your morning off gliding through the bayou on an airboat. Get an up close look at the wild life in the swampland with your local guide. We then return to the hotel, giving you time to explore the tastes and sounds of the city on your own. During your evening, you will have time to enjoy one of the Pre-Mardi Gras Parades from reserved grandstand seats. (B)

Day 4: Friday, 2/9 - Heading Northeast, we will first stop at Nottoway Plantation, the largest existing antebellum plantation home in the south. This home first built in 1859, is known for its beautiful architecture and oak draped lawns overlooking the Mississippi River. Continuing north along the river, we will explore the old and new capitol buildings in Baton Rouge. We then continue to Lafayette (2 nights). (B)







Day 5: Saturday 2/10 - Lafayette is considered the center of Acadian, the area of Cajun and Creole culture in Louisiana and the United States. Begin the day exploring **Vermilionville**, a living history museum and folk life park that promotes and propagates the cultural resources of the Acadian, Native American, and Creole people – from 1765 to 1890. Then see unique handmade accordions and enjoy a musical performance at the **Martin Accordions Company**. We end the night enjoying Cajun food and dancing at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 6: Sunday, 2/11 - Begin the morning at Avery Island, the home of Tabasco Sauce. This is a chance to see how the famous hot sauce is made on their private island. We then return to the New Orleans Airport and depart for home. (B)



DAY 1: DEPART USA - FLIGHT TO QUITO, ECUADOR

Arrive in Quito, Ecuador, located more than 9,000 feet above "seal level." Meet your Tour Director at the Mariscal Sucre International Airport and transfer to your hotel. Get acclimated to the elevation and settle in tonight.

Overnight: Quito

DAY 2: QUITO ECUADOR - MIDDLE OF THE WORLD

Following breakfast, enjoy a guided tour of Quito, the first UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site. Enjoy the eclectic architecture built over the last five centuries. See the Gothic Basilica of the Heart of Jesús (Basilica Corazon de Jesus) and the Metropolitan Cathedral (known simply as "la Catedral"), featuring an eclectic mix of architectural styles, from Moorish to Baroque and Neoclassical. Also see Independence Square flanked by the Presidential and the Archbishop's palaces. Visit the Jesuit Church of the Society of Jesus ("La Compañía de Jesús"), Quito's most ornate church and one the most significant Spanish Baroque architecture in South America. Also see San Francisco Plaza, a vast complex of religious art. Next visit the Middle of the World ("Mitad del Mundo") where the earth's equator passes through Ecuador at 0º0'0" latitude and stand with one foot in each half of the world. The 98-feet monument is built on the historic site where a French explorer calculated the line of the equator in 1736. Also see the colonial church and bull-fighting ring. The evening is at leisure to explore the city of Quito on your own.

DAY 3: QUITO - FLIGHT TO BALTRA - MV GALAPAGOS LEGEND

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your flight to Baltra Island in the Galapagos Islands. Upon arrival, meet your naturalist guide and transfer to the MV Galapagos Legend for your four-night cruise. Your cruise departs for Mosquera Islet, a tiny, low lying islet, covered in coral sand, located between North and South Seymour Islands. It is home to a group of sea lions that come to laze on the soft white sand. It is a good spot to observe shorebirds as well as herons, lava gulls and boobies. Rays, barracudas and sharks can also be seen snorkeling.

DAY 4: EGAS PORT (SANTIAGO ISLAND) - RABIDA ISLAND

This morning visit Santiago Island. A wet landing puts you on Egas Port, a black volcanic beach once visited by Darwin and sets this landing apart from most. This unique and dramatic shoreline hosts a variety of species that live between land and sea. Particular among these are the endemic Galapagos fur seals which maintain a small colony at the end of our walk. Other species of note include American oystercatchers, sea lions, waders, herons, lava lizards and even Galapagos hawks. Our afternoon adventure lies at the heart of the archipelago, with a visit to Rabida Island with its distinctive red-sand beach. Home to sea lions, mockingbirds, finches. endemic Galapagos doves and more. A walk takes us to a beautiful overview of the bay. Snorkeling here can be a highlight, often with sea lions, ubiquitous turtles and black-striped salemas.

DAY 5: URBINA BAY & TAGUS COVE (ISABELA ISLAND)

After breakfast our day begins with a wet landing on the beach at Urbina Bay. At the far end of a level hike we arrive at a strange phenomenon where large blocks of coral lie completely exposed after a dramatic geological uplift during the 1950's. Located at the western base of Alcedo Volcano, be on the lookout for impressive land iguanas as well as some of the volcano's endemic Galapagos giant tortoises. Excellent snorkeling today in the clear blue waters with an opportunity to see beautiful marine life up close. This afternoon we visit **Tagus Cove,** one of the few sites visited by Charles Darwin and the HMS Beagle in early 1800's and a well-known hideout in the days of pirates. A beautiful hike leads us past an overview of Darwin Lake and on to a stunning volcanic landscape revealing Isabela island's dramatic northern volcanoes. Once back at sea level, we have an opportunity to snorkel with fish, penguins, turtles and spot other sea and wildlife.

DAY 6: FERNANDINA ISLAND - ISABELA ISLAND

Today we visit Espinosa Point on Fernandina Island with a dry landing. The youngest island of Galapagos Islands and one of the most pristine in the world. Fernandina Island is referred to as the 'marine iguana capital of the world'. This volcanic backdrop is home to a huge concentration of these enigmatic reptiles. Sharing the same shoreline, we can find pelicans, the

diminutive Galapagos penguins, sea lions and fur seals all offering amazing photo opportunities. Here we also have the exciting opportunity to snorkel with marine iguanas feeding underwater, penguins, turtles and the bizarre, flightless cormorants, the only place this species is found in the world. This afternoon visit Vicente Roca Point on Isabela Island. This spectacular site is surrounded by immense cliffs of the eroded volcano. Studded with resting sea birds such as brown noddies and Nazca boobies, view them in close proximity from your dinghies. A marine-only visitor area, snorkeling here is superb and one of the richest marine havens in the Galapagos Islands with certain species of fish only found in the west of the archipelago. Here we have the opportunity to snorkel and swim with sunfish, sea horses, penguins and green turtles.

DAY 7: SANTA CRUZ ISLAND - TORTOISE RESERVE - FLIGHT QUITO

Today your Galapagos Islands cruise ends as you look back on all of the highlights, sights, marine life and wildlife encountered on your adventure. After a dry landing, disembark the ship and travel by coach into the central highlands of Santa Cruz Island to the Highlands Tortoise Reserve. Here have you an opportunity to interact up close with wild, Galapagos giant tortoises. A short walk among these huge, 600-pound reptiles offers great photo opportunities and the chance to see several species of the famed finches. Continue on to the Baltra Island airport for your flight to Quito. This evening enjoy a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers and new found friends.
