The Strawberry Social was her first volunteer experience after starting to come to the Harman Center. From there she started working in the kitchen for Saturday breakfasts, then she added the lunches, barbecues, potato feeds, and taco dinners.

When asked the best part of her job Maryann immediately said the people I work with. They are awesome people, we work so well together. Anything they are asked to do they do.

Maryann says she would advise anyone considering volunteering to try it. She said you will enjoy it very much. Everyone enjoys being there. Volunteering is a great way to give back to the community. Maryann made a statement that I will not forget. She said "Volunteers are the foundation".

She commented that there are many ways of volunteering. She mentioned one lady wrote a letter to the editor that told about the many things to do at the Harman Center. She felt that letter drew some people to attend the Center that might not have otherwise.

The Saturday breakfasts are another way people are drawn into the Center.

Maryann was recently in Lacey WA talking with a friend and the friend was amazed at all that can be done at our center. Without the Harman family's initial donation and the many people who volunteered to build programs, teach programs, and support those programs our active center would not be possible.

Thank you Maryann and volunteers for all you do. You are truly the foundation of our Center.

Marv stays busy both at the Center and outside. He is currently the President of the Yakima Lion Club.

The Harman Center — Moving Forward

There has been considerable activity surrounding the Request for Proposals (RFP) process for Operating and Management Services for the Harman Center. I have been actively involved in the process and working to ensure that the interests of our seniors and the future of the Harman Center remain at the forefront. The committee of five, have thoroughly reviewed the proposal from the Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Yakima. The scoring process of the proposal has been completed, and the recommendations and concerns from the committee have been submitted to the City of Yakima.

The process timeline is as follows;

- Aug 31 – Sept 30, 2026, City review of committee recommendations, contract negotiations, finalize award
- Oct 6, 2026 - City Council Contract approval (Council agenda).
- Dec 31, 2026 - Current City Operations End at the Harman Center.
- Jan 1, 2027 - Contract start date for the new Management organization.

One thing we want everyone to know is simple:

Rest assured, the Harman Center will remain open!

Yakima Valley Senior Citizen Inc. is committed to supporting the Harman Center and the seniors who depend on it as a place to gather, socialize, participate in activities, and enjoy the friendships that make the Harman Center such a special part of our community. We look forward to working with the new Management Organization once the contract has been finalized.

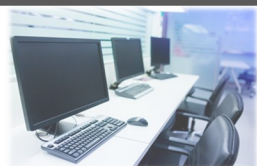
