



Fisher Park Golf Course would like to give you an update on how we plan on operating the golf course in the midst of the coronavirus pandemic. First and foremost, the safety of our customers and staff is our highest priority. We will be implementing and strictly enforcing, additional measures and precautions, as recommended by the CDC, throughout the course. We appreciate your patience and understanding at this time.

Please enjoy your game of golf while following these rules to ensure we can remain, open, clean and safe during this public health crisis.

- For golfers, if you are sick or are feeling sick, do not come to the golf course.
- All golfers MUST prepay their tee time online at [www.yakimaparks.com](http://www.yakimaparks.com). Must show paper or electronic receipt at check in window.
- Social Distancing Requirements must be observed at all times. A 6-foot separation must be maintained at all times.
- Please refrain from congregating as groups anywhere on the course, including on the patio and in the parking lot.
- Twosomes will only be allowed at this time, however if all golfers are from the same household they will be able to golf together up to a maximum of four golfers.
- To minimize exposure to our staff the clubhouse will be closed entirely for all services.
- Increasing the frequency of routine cleaning, sanitization and disinfection of all common areas and frequently touched surfaces.
- Providing PPE's to all staff and encourage them to wear them at all times.
- As recommended by the CDC, any employee who is sick will not be allowed to work. Any employee showing signs of any sickness while at work, will be immediately sent home.
- Rental clubs and pull carts will not be available.
- There will be no motorized golf carts available for use.
- Players must not touch the flagstick and must leave the pin in at all times.
- Golfers must only pick up their own ball and handle their own scorecard.
- Golfers should not use the air compressor for cleaning shoes or equipment following the round.
- Players should bring their own hand sanitizer or antibacterial wipes and use them throughout their round and after their round has been completed.
- We ask you to please forgo the traditional after round handshake.
- Finish and go home!
