



LIONS PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL RE-OPENING PROTOCOLS COVID - 19

OVERVIEW

Parks and Recreation staff would like to give you an update on how we plan on operating Lions Pool once the Governor's plan allows aquatics facilities to operate.

First and foremost, the safety of our customers and staff is our highest priority. We will be implementing and strictly enforcing additional measures and precautions, as recommended by the CDC, throughout pool facilities. Due to the unpredictability of COVID-19, operational interruptions may be unavoidable this summer. However, by teaming up together, we hope to have as few interruptions as possible and ask for your patience and cooperation as we go through this summer together.

Please enjoy your swim while following these rules to ensure pools can remain, open, clean, and safe during this public health emergency.

- **If you are sick or feeling sick, do not come to the pool.**
- **Social distancing requirements must be observed at all times. A 6-foot separation must be maintained at all times.**
- **Please refrain from congregating as groups anywhere in the pool area, lobby, or parking lot.**
- **To minimize exposure for staff and swimmers, we will be limiting the number of people allowed in the facility.**
- **Increased frequency of routine cleaning, sanitization, disinfection of all common areas and frequently touched surfaces.**
- **PPE will be provided to all staff and they will be required to wear them at all times.**
- **As recommended by the CDC, any employee who is sick will not be allowed to work. Any employee showing signs of sickness while at work will be immediately sent home.**
- **Until further notice, swim lessons will not be offered.**
- **Exercise equipment will be available as long as users place their used equipment in the return bins and not back on the racks.**
- **Users will pick up their own equipment not leaving it for others to handle.**
- **Staff will maintain filtration and recirculation systems according to manufacturer recommendations.**
- **To ensure swimmers safety, staff will test pH and disinfectant levels at least twice per day (hourly when in heavy use).**
